HMS Queen Elizabeth is the Fleet Flagship, the largest and most sophisticated Aircraft Carrier ever built for the Royal Navy.

Serving as a sea going airbase, she is equipped with a flight deck and hangar capable of carrying, deploying and recovering helicopters and fast jets, including F-35 lightning' and helicopters.

Two variants of the Merlin are part of the Carrier Strike Group.

Merlin Mk2 is equipped with a hi-tech suite of radar and a sonar to identify threats on, above and below the waves.

Merlin Mk4 provides essential support by moving equipped with a sonar and hi-tech suite of radar to identify threats on. Highly trained pilots can land this helicopter almost anywhere in the world.
